House Keeping Plan Check In-Out

- Entry Code-The Last four digits of your phone number. When you arrive, look for the Electrical Box behind the front door. Turn on all the breakers with White marks. When you leave turn off all the breakers with White marks
- Queen Size Bed, Full Size Futon, and Twin Futon are provided.
- Please bring your: __Sheets, __Pillows, __Blankets, __Towels, and __Dish Cloths
- The kitchen is furnished with dishes, glasses, cups, basic kitchen tools, coffeepot, toaster, microwave, range, & refrigerator. Feel free to use these, remember where you got things from, please clean them and put them back when you are finished.
- The Cottage is on a Holding Tank, so try to be conservative with your shower time. Call if alarm sounds.
- The water comes from a well, but it is high in iron. You should bring water for drinking and coffee.
- No phone will ring at the cabin, unless it is your mobile phone. We have Sprint phones and the service is excellent. WiFi is reliable. The Smart TV will play apps you have an account for, and a few channels.
- The parking area is pretty well defined. You can pull straight in or turn to the right as you enter.
- The fireplace in the living room works great. The fireplace in the Bedroom is decorative, enjoy the electric flame. The firepit by the water is inviting with comfortable seating. Wood is available, please be reasonable.
- If the weather is unseasonably cold, you may use the electric heat. There are thermostats in the living room, bedroom and a switch in the bathroom. When not in use, please turn them down all the way.
- Ample Cleaning Supplies are in the closet. The cottage should be clean when you arrive. If it is not to your satisfaction, you may submit a bill for additional supplies and a reasonable charge for your time.
- When leaving, please remember to return all furniture and furnishings to the way it was when you arrived
- No trash left on site. You should buy special orange trash bags at the gas station in Valmy or Bley's
 Grocery in Jacksonport. The Orange bags can be put in the dumpster at the gas station in Valmy without
 any additional charge. When you arrive, there is no trash, and no dead fish heads. No trash left on site
 - 1. . Close windows when you leave.
 - 2. Remove all Trash See instruction just above Leave no food or leftovers.
 - 3. Clean the Cottage to the satisfaction of the next guest.
 - 4. Turn off the Electrical Breakers with the White marks
 - 5. Lock the Cottage and Storage Shed
 - 6. _____Check out time is 12:00 noon, unless otherwise arranged
