House Keeping Plan Check In-Out

- **Entry Code-Last four digits of Phone number.** On arrival, look for the Electrical Box in the bathroom closet. Turn on all the breakers with White marks. When you leave turn off all the breakers with White marks.
 - Queen Size Bed, and Two Twin Beds are provided.
 - Please bring your: __Sheets, __Pillows, __Blankets, __Towels, and __Dish Cloths
 - The kitchen is furnished with dishes, glasses, cups, basic kitchen tools, coffeepot, toaster, microwave, range, & refrigerator. Feel free to use these, remember where you got things from, please clean them and put them back when you are finished.
 - The Cottage is on a Holding Tank, so try to be conservative with shower time. Call if red light goes on.
 - The water comes from a well, but it is high in iron. You should bring water for drinking and coffee.
 - No phone will ring at the cabin unless it is your mobile phone. We have Sprint phones and the service is Excellent. **The WiFi is reliable.** The Smart TV can play any apps you have an account for & few Channels.
 - **You must enter and leave from North.** The parking area is well defined but limited. Watch for the well.
 - The fireplace in the living room is decorative only. Feel free to use it, find the switch for the electric log.
 - The fire pit by the water is inviting with comfortable seating. Wood is available, please be reasonable.
 - If the weather is unseasonably cold, you may use the electric heat. There are thermostats in the living room, and switch in the bedroom. When not in use, please turn them down all the way.
 - Ample Cleaning Supplies are in the closet. The cottage should be clean when you arrive. If it is not to your satisfaction, you may submit a bill for additional supplies and a reasonable charge for your time.
 - When leaving, please remember to return all furniture and furnishings the way it was when you arrived.
 - **No trash left on site.** You should buy special orange trash bags at the gas station in Valmy or Bley's Grocery in Jacksonport. The oranges bags can be put in the dumpster at the gas station in Valmy without any additional charge. When you arrive, there is no trash and no dead fish heads. No trash left on site.
